Feigenholtz Hosting Town Hall Meeting

CHICAGO – State Representative Sara Feigenholtz (D-Chicago) announced she will host a public town hall meeting on Tuesday, July 5, at 6:30 p.m. in the Center on Halsted’s Hoover-Leppen Theater located at 3656 North Halsted Street in Lakeview.

While the town hall meeting will allow residents to discuss any issue they desire, the focus will be on the FY12 state budget. As the chairperson for the House Human Services Appropriations Committee that oversees more than \$12 billion in state spending, Feigenholtz played a prominent role in crafting the state budget. Feigenholtz will also address some of the most pertinent legislation addressed in the past legislative session, including the sweeping changes made to the state’s workers compensation system, education reform and gaming expansion.

“The legislature adjourned for the summer, but there are still lingering issues that will be addressed in the coming months,” Feigenholtz said. “I am already looking ahead to the FY13 human services budget and continue to work with stakeholders on pension reform and other important issues. We have another tough year ahead of us and will stay busy through the summer recess.”

Attendees will also have the opportunity ask questions and share their thoughts on state government and legislative issues.

“I have been speaking with community groups and going door-to-door listening to constituent concerns,” Feigenholtz said. “This town hall is another opportunity for citizens to become more informed, ask questions about the issues they care about, and express their own ideas and thoughts for making state government work for everyone.”
