Rep. Feigenholtz Holds Workshop to Help Local Business Owners

CHICAGO – State Representative Sara Feigenholtz (D-Chicago) and the Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES) hosted a business services workshop in Lakeview on Thursday to help employers understand the range of state services available to them.

Attendees were given information on state tax credits, TaxNet, Illinois Skills Match, and other programs available to help Illinois employers recruit skilled workers and utilize state resources.
