

# Representative Feigenholtz Hosts Credit Seminar

State Representative Sara Feigenholtz (D-Chicago) announced she will host a credit seminar on Thursday, July 7, at 6:30 p.m. at the 23<sup>rd</sup> District Police Station Community Room, at 850 W. Addison.
