Rep. Feigenholtz Seminar to Address RTA, Fraud Concerns for Senior Citizens

CHICAGO – State Representative Sara Feigenholtz (D-Chicago) will host two seminars for senior citizens on Wednesday, October 19 at the 23rd District Police Station located at 850 West Addison in Lakeview.

At 10:00 a.m., the Regional Transit Authority will offer a presentation on changes to services and programs for senior citizens, including the seniors ride free and reduced fare programs. The RTA representative will also take questions, concerns and suggestions for improving services for senior citizens.

At 11:00 a.m., the Office of Illinois Attorney General Lisa Madigan will facilitate a “Silver Beat” training seminar. The training session will cover a variety of topics including consumer rights under the new credit card rules, the Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP) Project, health care fraud, reverse mortgages, debt settlement traps, fake check-cashing schemes, and tips on avoiding exploitation and scams.

“Both of these seminars are very important for this community’s senior citizens,” said Feigenholtz. “The RTA issues are prominent right now with the changes to the fare programs and cards for senior citizens. Seniors and their loved ones are always concerned about the latest fraud and scam opportunities. This is going to be an incredibly informational morning for our seniors and I hope folks take advantage of these resources.”
