Rep. Feigenholtz Announces “Coffee and Conversation” Listening Session

CHICAGO – State Rep. Sara Feigenholtz (D-Chicago) will host her next “Coffee and Conversation” listening session on Thursday, November 3 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Starbucks Coffee located at 1023 West Addison in Lakeview.

The week following the Coffee and Conversation listening session is the second and final week of the legislature’s fall veto session. Issues involving the state budget, Medicaid and human services funding and pension reform are expected to be prominent legislative concerns. Feigenholtz is actively seeking constituent input on these and other state issues.

“It is crucial that I stay in contact with residents during these busy few weeks of veto session,” Feigenholtz said. “I really want to hear what folks think about some these tough issues. I need to know what my district and the people I represent are thinking.”

Feigenholtz has hosted numerous coffee shop constituent meet-ups over the past several months. Residents are encouraged to attend and share their ideas on state government, suggest state budget cuts, or just come to have a cup of coffee and chat.
