

## Rep. Feigenholtz Announces Food Drive and Volunteer Event to Benefit Lakeview Pantry

State Rep. Sara Feigenholtz (D-Chicago) announced a fall food drive that will conclude with a volunteer outing to the Lakeview Pantry, where the donated items will be distributed to local residents in need.

Items needed most include peanut butter, jelly, whole grain products (e.g. cereal and pasta), canned tuna, canned meat, canned beans or vegetables, canned fruit in juice, low sodium soup, vegetable juice or V8, toothbrushes, toothpaste and other non-perishable, non-expired food items.

"The past few years have been tough on working families and local pantries," Feigenholtz said. "The economy has driven up the demand for food items and warm clothing. It is really important that, especially with Thanksgiving just around the corner, we remember to take care of those around us."

On **Saturday, November 19**, Feigenholtz invites residents to join her in volunteering at the Lakeview Pantry located at **3831 North Broadway**. The Lakeview Pantry's Broadway location primarily serves Lakeview residents living east of Racine. From 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., volunteers will help process incoming donations and prepare for the pantry's weekly home delivery service. Volunteers that drive also have the option of delivering food to individuals and families in the community.

Food items may be dropped off Monday through Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at Feigenholtz's constituent services office located at 1051 West Belmont.
