Feigenholtz Hosts Coffee Shop Meet-Up for Constituents

CHICAGO – State Rep. Sara Feigenholtz (D-Chicago) is hosting her next “Coffee and Conversation” listening session on Wednesday, December 7 from 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. at Saugatuck Coffee located at 3344 North Halsted in Lakeview.

The “Coffee and Conversation” listening session falls just after the legislature wraps up two extra days in session the week prior, when issues such as gaming, corporate tax breaks and pension reform could be voted on.

“I enjoy meeting with constituents during these legislative breaks and getting a better idea of where residents stand on these issues,” said Feigenholtz. “Residents from all walks of life come to tell me what they want to see in state government, ask questions about some of the complex issues we’re dealing with, and to give me suggestions on potential legislation. It’s nice to be able to have an honest conversation and exchange ideas back and forth.”

Feigenholtz hosts monthly coffee shop constituent meet-ups as an opportunity to meet with residents in smaller groups. Residents are encouraged to attend and share their ideas on state government, suggest state budget cuts, or just come to have a cup of coffee and chat.
