

## Phone bill clinic helps residents save on phone bills

State Rep. Sara Feigenholtz (D-Chicago) is hosting a phone bill analysis clinic where trained experts from the Citizens Utility Board (CUB) will review residents' current phone bills and suggest how they can save money. This free event will be held on Thursday, May 10 at 1:00 p.m. at Weiss Memorial Hospital (Conference Room 4-A) located at 4646 North Marine in Uptown.

Attendees should bring their current landline or cell phone bill to the event. A specialist from CUB will conduct a one-on-one phone bill analysis to help residents cut unnecessary and often costly and

confusing features from their phone service.

"Trimming the fat from our monthly bills – even by just a few dollars – can go a long way," said Feigenholtz. "At minimum, residents attending this clinic will leave with a better understanding of the charges and fees on their bills. At best, residents will walk away with the tools to save a significant amount of money each year by cutting out the unneeded charges.
