CHICAGO, Ill. — In celebration of the Grand Opening of the Fred and Pamela Buffett Place, state Rep. Sara Feigenholtz, D-Chicago, welcomed the flagship affordable housing facility into the community. The development is the result of a public-private partnership between Brinshore Development, the City of Chicago and Thresholds, Illinois' largest provider of mental health services.
