Are you happy? Well, now you'll have a designated time to be happy each day as Illinois Lawmakers officially passed The Culinary and Hospitality Modernization Act (SB 398) into Law. It's on! Gov. Bruce Rauner signed the bill Wednesday afternoon officially marking the return of Happy Hour to Illinois effective immediately. The law allows for discounts for up to 4 hours a day and up to 15 hours a week as long as they are promoted a week in advance.

There are limitations to the Happy Hour Law including serving two or more drinks to one person for consumption by that person, increasing the volume of alcoholic liquor contained in a drink or the size of a drink, without proportionally increasing the price regularly charged for that drink on that given day, and more.
