Feigenholtz and Williams to Host Community Public Safety Forum

CHICAGO - State Rep. Sara Feigenholtz, D-Chicago, and Rep. Ann Williams will host a Community Public Safety Forum on Thursday, October 27th from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at St. Luke's Church located at 1500 W. Belmont.

Four expert speakers, including Representatives Mike Zalewski and Elgie Sims, along with Colleen Daley of the Illinois Council against Handgun Violence will discuss proposed legislation to keep guns off the streets.

"It's important for our constituents to know what measures we are taking to mitigate these crimes at the state capitol. Our community has faced increasing concerns about safety. Citywide, gun related violent crimes are on the rise," Feigenholtz added. "It is critically important that we push for stronger, targeted gun laws that will keep offenders who are illegally in possession of guns off the streets." In addition, Marcus Williams, a reformed burglar, will discuss ways to mitigate crime in our area and provide helpful tips on crime prevention.
